The Airports Board met on Thursday September 19, 2013 at 1:30 p.m., in the Council Chambers of the Beaufort County Government Center. Chairman Buchanan called the meeting to order and led the attendees in the Pledge of Allegiance.

MOTION TO ACCEPT AGENDA

Motion: It was moved by Mr. Ahern, seconded by Mr. Spain that the September 19, 2013 agenda be approved. The vote was: FOR – Mr. Buchanan, Mr. Dopp, Mr. Gilbert, Mr. Ahern, Mr. Sells, Mr. Spain, Mr. Smetek, Ms. Esposito and Mr. Wedler. AGAINST – None. ABSENT – Mr. Kerr and Mr. Sanders. MOTION PASSED.

GUEST INTRODUCTIONS AND PUBLIC COMMENTS

No comments.

REMARKS BY THE CHAIRMAN

Mr. Buchanan introduced the new Board member, Anne Esposito. He stated Ms. Esposito will also serve on the subcommittee.

Mr. Buchanan reminded the Board members of the requirements for meeting attendance.

LADY'S ISLAND AIRPORT REPORT

Mr. Phillips reported on the fuel sales and operations for the Lady's Island Airport for August. He stated the operations are up approximately 27% over the same time period as last year and the fuel flow is up approximately 25%.

Mr. McFee stated SCE&G has until March 2014 to either lower or light the power poles in the approach. There are 4 avigation easements remaining and are scheduled for court in late October. Mr. McFee stated the FAA has reviewed the Master Plan and they did not make any comments. The plan is currently being reviewed by the SC Aeronautics Commission and should be finished this week. Mr. McFee stated quotes have been received for the restrooms and that the tree removal plans are moving forward. He stated he made a presentation to Beaufort County ATAX Board for the Air Day, but no funds were received.

HILTON HEAD ISLAND AIRPORT REPORT

Chief Yeager gave the tower and operations reports as well as the noise complaints for August.

Mr. McFee stated the Runway 21 on-airport obstruction removal revised plans and specs are underway and will be rebid in October for replanting. He stated the 20:1 to 30:1 design work for the obstruction removal is proceeding. Mr. McFee stated we have 9 out of 17 avigation easements.

Mr. McFee stated the Phase I Airport Improvements Environmental Assessment report is underway and a draft report is expected at the end of October or the first of November. He stated the Phase III Archeology Data Recovery will be incorporated into the Environmental Assessment.

Mr. McFee stated terminal renovations will be rebid. He also stated a decision has not been received from the FAA concerning the Modifications to Standards for the runway lighted sign replacement project.

Mr. McFee stated there is a bid alternate to address the rust on the exterior of the terminal building.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

1. Lady's Island Airport Operations – Graham Kerr – No Report

2. Hilton Head Island Airport Operations – Will Dopp

Mr. Dopp stated the movements are down 9% and passenger count is down 6%. He stated Signature Flight Support's revenues are down by 4% and the County's share for the eight months is \$171,000.00. He stated the fuel revenues for Signature were down 5%. Signature will begin shortly on their \$200,000.00 terminal renovation project that will be done in phases and hopefully finished in the first quarter of 2014. Mr. Dopp stated Republic Parking is up compared to this time last year.

3. Subcommittee/Air Carrier Service Improvements at Hilton Head Island Airport – Al Spain

Mr. Spain stated the committee was established and at their last meeting they determined their goals. He stated that at their meeting today they will try to better define the process for improving airline service.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Airports Board 2014 Meeting Schedule – Pete Buchanan

Mr. Buchanan asked the Board if they wanted to continue meeting on the third Thursday of every month. It was a consensus of the Board to retain the current schedule.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Hilton Head Island ATAX – Rob McFee

Mr. McFee stated we have been turned down in the past and wanted to know if the Board wanted him to try again and if they had any ideas for a different approach. Mr. Ahern suggested a safety seminar at the Airport in connection with the Ambassador Program. Mr. Dopp stated they might try for funds for an Air Day in hopes of getting rid of the legal opinion from TERC concerning police and fire services. Mr. Buchanan and Ms. Esposito concurred. Mr. McFee stated he would proceed with the Hilton Head Island Airport ATAX using the Air Day approach.

PUBLIC COMMENTS CONTINUED

1. Joe Zimmerman, Resident – Mr. Zimmerman asked the Board members to move closer to the microphones as the guests at the Hilton Head Island Library only heard about 15% of the meeting.
