#### Justification for the Silver vs. Bronze Maintenance Plan

The Board of Elections and Registration is requesting an upgrade to the ES&S Silver Maintenance Plan vs the Bronze Plan for several reasons:

- The difference between the two options really made sense when it came to major maintenance on the lvoTronic machines. Mandatory iVo Motherboard battery replacement has to take place approximately every 5 years or less. The first wave of our machines (369) are due this calendar year. The cost associated with this maintenance is a difference of \$7380.00 under the Silver vs the Bronze. There is also a mandatory bi-annual visit locally to carry out the maintenance.
- Another line item difference is, under Silver the company will travel to our site and perform the mandatory maintenance. This precludes the cost of shipping the 369 machines, 700 miles round trip, either by renting a truck at \$45.00 dollars a day for four days and 1400 miles @\$.60 per mile or paying the astronomical cost of a carrier shipping the machines. Add to that the extra wear and tear, man-hours and logistics to make the transfer for the maintenance. This maintenance takes approximately one and half to two weeks, and with the Bronze plan we would leave the machines and then return to pick them up.
- The other aspect to keep in mind with the two plans is that the bronze plan only offers a "Break-Fix" option where the majority of the repairs garner a \$195.00 per/hour labor cost while with the Silver the labor cost are included at the reduced rate of the repairs, as well as "always" having to ship everything.
- The original thinking in starting out with the Bronze plan was that the Election Technical Systems Specialist at the time was Mr. Eric Montgomery, who was trained in performing some of the minor maintenance himself, thus the need for an upgraded plan wasn't so pressing, as well as the machines were newer. However, now that Mr. Montgomery is no longer with us and the machines are very dated and can require extensive preventive maintenance, it is prudent that use a more comprehensive plan.

I hope this reasoning can help you understand why we felt compelled to upgrade the maintenance contract.
